European Chafer

Chris Maund (chris.maund@gnb.ca), IPM Specialist and Provincial Apiarist, Dept of Agriculture, Aquaculture and Fisheries has reported the first finding of an adult European chafer in Fredericton on July 11, 2019.

The following information may help for monitoring and applying a control for the first instar:

The eggs are laid singly in an earthen cell, 5 to 10 cm deep. A newly deposited egg is 0.5 mm wide by 0.7 mm long and becomes about 2.3 mm by 2.8 mm just before hatching. The egg stage lasts two weeks and the first instar lasts three weeks.
